

EAFT Annual Report 2023

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1. General

1.1 EAFT General Assembly – 29 November 2022

The 2022 EAFT General Assembly (GA) was held online on 29 November 2022. The corresponding minutes were distributed amongst the members together with the formal convocation to the 2023 GA.

1.3 **Board meetings**

During 2023, the Board has met in real life three times, but has also started more regular, shorter online meetings in between the real-life meetings:

On 17 February 2022 an ordinary meeting of the EAFT Board took place at TERMCAT. The Board also visited the Institute of Catalan Studies and met with the president Teresa Cabré. This reception was an initial step in the cooperation between EAFT, TERMCAT and the Institute of Catalan Studies for the celebration of the XI European Terminology Summit at the Institute of Catalan Studies.

• 19 April (Brussels)

On 19 April 2023, coinciding with the conference *Terminology: Domain Loss and Gain*, the Board met in Brussels to discuss the Summit, the new edition of the EAFT Awards and the activity plan for the second half of 2023.

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• 15 November (Barcelona)

On 15 November 2023, coinciding with the Summit, the Board met in Barcelona to discuss the latest details of the Summit organization and the planning of the new activities for 2024.

2. EAFT Activities

2.1 **Conference:** *Terminology: Domain Loss and Gain*

The EAFT co-organized the conference *Terminology: Domain Loss and Gain*, held in Brussels on 20–21 April 2023, with Infoterm and Instituut voor de Nederlandse Taal. The conference addressed theoretical discussions on and practical examples of domain loss and gain.

2.2 **TSR Journal**

The first issue of the EAFT Journal "Terminology Science & Research" (TSR) was published on 31 March 2023. The theme of the issue, No. 26, was "Terminology in Challenging Circumstances". The journal is an international scientific journal that focuses on theoretical and applied terminology and terminology related research, teaching and training, management, tools and terminology policies. The editors are Niina Nissilä (University of Vasa, Finland), Úna Bhreathnach (Dublin City University, Ireland) and Anca-Marina Velicu (University of Bucharest, Romania). The call for papers for No. 27 was issued on 16 May 2023.

2.3 ITA Awards

The two International Terminology Awards are The International Award for Distinguished Achievement in Terminology (MA level) and The International Award for Outstanding Achievement in Terminology Research and Development (PhD level).

Thirteen valid candidatures were submitted for the 2023 Awards. An international jury, chaired by Mojca Žagar Karer, examined the works (seven PhD theses – written in English, French and Spanish – and six MA theses – written in German, English, French, Italian and Spanish).

2.9 Nordterm conference in Stockholm

2.11 **TermNet Board Representative**

EAFT Board member Elena Chiocchetti was elected into the TermNet board at their General Assembly 2023. This can promote further co-operation between the EAFT and Infoterm.

2.12 **EAFT website and new logotype**

The EAFT Secretariat is commissioned to ensure that the EAFT corporate identity will be used in a correct way by using the same visual system throughout all its interactions (events, documents, website, merchandise). The EAFT website, revamped in 2021, has been continuously updated and work with the Catalan designer Mari Fouz has continued (with graphic material for the Summit).



The new logotype, designed by the same graphic artist, was also launched during 2023:



2.13 Newsletter

The EAFT newsletter is published every month – except August, which is covered by the July issue – in order to maintain an active and regular means of communication among all members.



The Newsletter is divided into several sections:

- **News**: a section aiming to inform about new projects or initiatives organized by the Association's members.
- **Agenda**: this section is devoted to the international terminological agenda and informs of events which can be of interest to all members.
- **Articles**: this section is aiming to improve knowledge exchange among EAFT members. This section allows recent papers or publications from members to be highlighted.
- **Publications**: This section allows members to present publications.
- **Suggestions**: this section encourages all members to share their news and events in upcoming issues of the newsletter.

The Newsletter's sections are fed by contributions mainly from EAFT members. The contributions can be sent in English or in French or in both, and also in every member's language. To date, EAFT counts more than 250 Newsletter subscriptions.

2.14 **X/Twitter**

EAFT's X/Twitter account has **1 100 followers**, among others active members of the European terminology scene. Contributions and news about our activities are fed and encouraged by the Secretariat and EAFT followers. Posts, mentions and retweets reflect the dynamism of terminology in Europe together with an active promotion of multilingualism. 2.15 **Visits**

2.15.1 Visit to Nuuk, Greenland

The EAFT President, Henrik Nilsson, has visited Oqaasileriffik (The Language Secretariat of Greenland) and taught an intensive course on terminology for them.

3. Financial matters

3.1 Accounts and Financial report 2022

The accounts for 2022 have been approved and signed by the auditors, Susanne Lervad and Maja Bratanić.

On 31 October 2023 the balance registered on the bank account was 26.115,13 (2022: 16.501). To this date, the annual fees paid amount to nearly 6.095 EUR. Funds from the IITF have been transferred from the previous Finnish account (7343 EUR) and will be allocated to cover the planned SIG for research, we have received also 4.000 EUR from DGLFLF to sponsor the Summit. The main expenditures this year have been allocated to cover the Eleventh Terminology Summit, sponsor the ITA Awards as well as the regular EAFT costs (secretariat duties, meeting expenses, Chamber of Commerce fee, website domain fee, etc.).

Besides, the Secretariat was paid the agreed annual amount (1500 EUR) for necessary expenses (administrative tasks, EAFT mail campaigns, tech and legal advice, membership campaign, bank duties management, communication activities, events organization, design editing process, etc.).

It is also relevant to be aware that the total of the membership fees received in 2023 only represent half of the sum expected when counting all members. It is most important that all the individuals and institutions who have traditionally been EAFT members are prepared to pay their subscriptions. If not, the accumulated capital of the association may be further reduced in following years putting at risk its financial standing in the long run and restricting future activities.

3.2 EAFT Account

As has previously been reported, fees have risen substantially for the EAFT account at ABN-AMRO in Amsterdam in the Netherlands, opened in 2000. Several options to resolve this issue have been investigated (including a dissolution of the association with a refounding and an opening of a brand new account somewhere else), but work will continue to find a solution during 2024.

Funds from the IITF have been transferred from their previous Finnish account (7.343 EUR), since that account had to be closed. The money has been marked for work related to research, continuing in the spirit of IITF.

3.3 Budget 2023

To sum up, it is estimated that our balance at the end of the year will be 21.317,54 EUR. In a Summit year the expenses tend to be higher than in years between Summits. This year has also seen extra bank fees for institutions based outside the Netherlands.

The economic situation may be considered stable, but without the annual fees from our members, the association can not go on supporting activities.

4. Activity plan for 2024

4.1 **New SIG for research**

During 2024, the planned SIG for research will start.

4.2 **Continued revisions of statutes**

Work on revising the statutes will continue with legal advice, especially of those sections concerning the Advisory Council.

4.3 ITA Awards

The Board will revise the ITA regulations.

4.4 **TSR – second issue**

Work on the second issue of the TSR will continue with a view to publication in November 2024.

4.5 **Summit 2025**

The Board will start planning the next EAFT Summit.

4.6 **Support to local terminology events**

EAFT would like to continue supporting (if economically possible) local events in 2024 and encourage members to propose such events.

4.7 **Continued membership campaign**

Work on recruiting more members will also continue as will the work on finding more member benefits and new agreements.

4.8 **EAFT website**

During 2024, work on adding material to the sections of the website will continue and more EAFT publications will be made available.

4.9 **Co-operation**

New co-operation will be investigated during 2024, e.g. with Efnil.

4.10 Louis-Jean Rousseau and Heidi Suonuuti

Renowned terminologists Louis-Jean Rousseau (Canada) and Heidi Suonuuti (Finland) both left us in 2023.
